

What are 'biodiversity sanctuaries'?

Sites that:

- experimentally restore NZ ecosystems to indigenous dominance and full species complement
- control or eradicate a broad suite of pests with best practice techniques
- reintroduce missing species
- manage a permanent and substantial risk of pest reinvasion
- inspire and galvanise communities to local conservation

We identified 82 such projects on or near the NZ mainland

HABITAT TE HENGA

- AIM: Improve existing biodiversity and plan for new
- 500-600 ha incl private, Akld Council, DOC, F & B
- Target mustelids (whole area), cats (some sites), rats (F & B)
- Has matuku, matata, crakes, grey-faced petrel, diving petrel, flesh-footed and sooty shearwaters, pipits, NZ & banded dotterel
- First translocation: pateke, Jan. 2015

MAHAKIRAU FOREST ESTATE

- Community-managed ecological restoration in the Coromandel Range
- AIM: Be 'wellspring' for native flora and fauna
- 580 ha private land, involving QEII, DOC, Waik. Reg. Council, Akld Zoo, Kiwis for Kiwi, Otago and Massey Universities,
- Target mustelids (450 ha), possums & rats (550 ha)
- Has Coromandel striped gecko, Archey's and Hochstetter frogs, kaka, kiwi, Helm's butterflies, painted cave weta, longfin eel, kokopu spp.
- Tim & Jude Hoosen, Sara Smerdon et al.

Future role of sanctuaries?

- Offshore eradications → mainland islands → diverse sanctuaries/scales
- Predator Free NZ Trust est. 2013
- SONZI incorporated July 2014
- PFNZ announced July 20 2016
- PF2050 Ltd board appointed Nov. 2016; CE Ed Chignell apppointed June 2017

2025 goals:

- 1. To develop a new technique capable of eradicating one of the target species
- 2. To achieve eradication of targets on 20,000+ ha without a fence
- 3. To suppress targets on a further MILLION ha
- 4. To eradicate all predators from offshore island nature reserves

Sanctuaries:

- 1. Have been living and breathing PFNZ for years
- 2. Are likely to be the cores of 'core and buffer' restoration zones
- 3. Depend on the hearts and minds of volunteer NZers
- 4. Have no obvious impending funding support.
